PROFILE BUILDING: 5 DOS AND DON'TS

1. Do customize your profile building activities to your existing profile and future requirements.
2. Do not undertake stereotypical activities just to list them on your resume.
3. Do give time to build your profile.
4. Do not take up multiple activities and stop them abruptly. This can indicate non-commitment.
5. Do take expert advice at every step and do not start acting on random suggestions. Just because it worked for someone does not mean it will work for you.



UNIVERSITY SHORTLISTING: 5 DOS AND DON'TS



1. Do select universities as per the 'good fit' factor.
2. Do not select universities only based on ranking or suggestions from friends and relatives.
3. Do apply to a wide range of universities covering the 'dream', 'moderate' and 'reach' categories.
4. Do not apply to too many or too few universities.
5. Do take expert opinion since this step can make or break.

DOCUMENT EDITING: 5 DOS AND DON'TS

1. Do have proper templates to guide you
2. Do not use too ornate language
3. Do get your work edited thoroughly
4. DO NOT plagiarize
5. Do maintain a proper structure and flow, all the while understanding the requirements from the document and thereby highlighting the key points.



APPLICATIONS: 5 DOS AND DON'TS



1. Do fill in all the required fields accurately.
2. Do not give false or inaccurate information.
3. Do upload clear scan copies of all required documents
4. Do not inaccurately convert grades to a different scale. Convert using the instructions provided, if and when needed.
5. Do get your application reviewed by an expert to avoid submitting erroneous applications.

VISA APPLICATION: 5 DOS AND DON'TS

1. Do understand the exact document requirements of the country.
2. Do not try to submit unnecessary documents.
3. Do be very attentive to the financial requirements of the study program and thereby the visa application.
4. Do not be late in filing for visa.
5. Do practice well and appropriately for visa interviews, if any. The preparations should be based on information gathered over the internet, but rather guided by an expert.
